

SUMMARY

1. **The author of the article (if any) and the name of the article are mentioned in the first sentence. – IF NOT - FAIL**
2. The summary has **a clear and coherent structure**. The form and content of the summary is of excellent quality and includes an **introduction, main section and a conclusion**.
3. The introduction includes a **concisely summed-up main topic of the article**.
4. The student has demonstrated an excellent understanding of the article they are summarizing by clearly outlining **all of the key points** from it. **Key points are in the same order** as in the article.
5. The summary **does not contain unnecessary supporting details**, such as specific information, statistics, percentages etc, but only main ideas and key points.
6. The summary includes only the information from the article, with **no subjective opinions**.
7. Referencing to the article is correct: **quotation marks are always used when quoting the article**. Quotations comprise a maximum of 20% of the summary.
8. **The student uses their own words to sum up the article**.
9. Sentences are clear, with correct and very confident use of language and terminology from the article. There are none or very **few grammatical and/or spelling errors**.
10. The conclusion **sums up the main point of the article** concisely, with no subjective opinions or added information.
